The Benefits of entering the Surrey Gingerbread competition are:

Students will gain valuable experience and information on how they can improve their skill levels by attending and viewing other entries, plus meet other young culinarians from neighboring schools. Winning awards is a big achievement and can have some benefits when students are moving on to the next level of their culinary pursuits.

All competitors will receive a participation certificate and a chance of earning a Gold (90 -100 points), Silver (80-90 points), or Bronze award (70-80 points). In addition top prizes will be handed out for each of the following categories:

- **Best Overall Entry**
- **Best theme throughout**
- **Best use of color**
- **Best table presentation**
- **Most unique / original idea**
- **Most Skillful Use of Icing**

Terms and Conditions:

1. 2018 Surrey Gingerbread Competition is open to all high school students enrolled in a culinary arts program in the province of British Columbia.
2. Students may work in teams of up to three students.
3. Teams **must** decorate their tables (table cloths, festive decorations).
4. The gingerbread construction is to be built using sheets of baked Gingerbread. The structure should be totally edible. There must be no additional artificial support material used to hold the structure, gluing of pieces should be done using icing.
5. The completed gingerbread piece must be displayed on a cake board or similar structure and must be no larger than 3ft x 3ft.
6. Only one entry per team is permitted.
7. All teams are responsible for final clean-up of their work space including garbage disposal and are asked to assist in putting down tables etc. This will be completed after the prizes are awarded.

Judging Terminology & Criteria Explained:

The judging of gingerbread pieces in this competition is based on the below listed key criteria areas. Judges will use below as a reference:

- **General Appearance:**
 - Overall impression of gingerbread piece
 - Using a well presented theme or idea

- **Colour:**
 - Gingerbread colour
 - Use of a variety of colours to lift the eye appeal

- **Aroma:**
 - Aroma of gingerbread.
 - Overall aroma of product

- **Originality / Uniqueness:**
 - Design / unique, difficulty and eye for detail.
 - Decorations used / skill level, original ideas, matching the theme

- **Technical Difficulty:**
 - Design – free standing
 - Piping work – neat and skillful
 - Decorations used – clean and consistent finish

Disqualifications: All gingerbread entries must be constructed of 100% edible food products.

Entries that do not meet the specified entry criteria either by size or other reason will be disqualified.

Entries Drop Off: 8:30am to 9:30am / out of district entrees can make arrangements with Chef Doyle to drop-off show pieces the day ahead.

Judging: From 9:30am to 11:30am **restricted access, Judges and show organizers only.**

Public Viewing: 11:30am to 12:30pm

Awards and Presentations: 12:30pm to 1:30
